

## Social Prescribing

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The Level 3 Certificate in Social Prescribing will prepare you for a role in social prescribing and provides those already working in this area with a deeper level of knowledge and understanding of social prescribing.

### What are the entry requirements?

You will need a GCSE in English Grade 9-4 (A\*-C) or Functional Skills English Level 2. Previous experience in the subject, through work or education, is desirable.

It would be an advantage for any undertaking this Certificate to have access to a relevant working environment or simulated working environment in Health Care, Social Care, or the Voluntary Community Social Enterprise sector.
